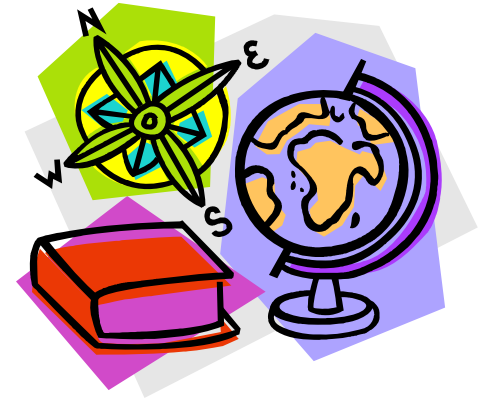

Jumpstart (Entering K)

This 3-hour class is offered to incoming Kindergartners who could benefit from a “Jumpstart” into Kindergarten. It is by recommendation only. Students are selected based on their Dial-3 screening that is completed in April prior to the start of Kindergarten.

Remediation (Gr. K-7)

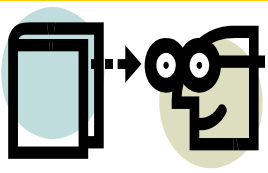
These classes are offered to help support students in either Language Arts, Math, or both. Classes are 1.5 hrs. long and utilize a selected summer curriculum to help support students in area of need.

Extended School Year (Special Education)

Summer programming designed for students with special education needs, determined by their Individualized Education Plan. Program is utilized to help maintain skills.

English Language Learning (Current Grade 2)

Summer programming designed to support students transitioning from Bi-Lingual/ESL into increased English instruction.

Summer Science Lab (Current Grades 4-5)

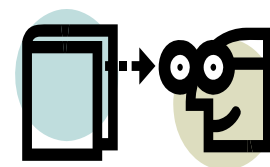
Researched-based lab program with science fair as culminating activity.
