River Trails School District 26 Board of Education Member Susan Stolzer Resigns, District Begins Process of Filling the Vacancy

MOUNT PROSPECT, IL – River Trails School District 26 announced the resignation of Dr. Susan Stolzer from its Board of Education, effective August 2, 2022. The district will immediately begin the process of filling the vacancy as dictated by its policy for the appointment of a Board member.

“Dr. Stolzer’s more than five years of service to the district has been exemplary,” Board President William Grimpe said. “We are grateful for her dedication and will miss her passion for public education. The Board is eager to begin searching for a replacement who is equally qualified and committed to serving River Trails. Even as that process plays out, our work on behalf of students, staff and the community-at-large will remain the top priority.”

Applications for the vacancy created by the resignation may be obtained at the district’s administrative office, located at 1900 East Kensington Road, Mount Prospect, and on the district website at www.rtsd26.org.

In order to be a candidate for the Board vacancy a person must show proof that they are a citizen of the United States, lives in Illinois and in District 26 for more than a year, is a registered voter, at least eighteen years of age, and shall not be a child sex offender as defined in Section 11-9.3 of the Criminal Code of 2012. Applications will be accepted until Friday, September 2, 2022 at 4:00 p.m. The Board will contact individual candidates for interviews. At the conclusion of the interviewing process, a candidate will be selected for appointment at the September 20, 2022 Board of Education meeting. The chosen applicant will serve until May 2023.
